Sir,

I have the honour to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of October 12th by which you informed me that the Government of Albania requests to be admitted to the League of Nations. Such admission is, as your Government is no doubt aware, governed by the terms of Article I of the Covenant of the League.

I am immediately informing all the Members of the League of the request of the Albanian Government, and it will be submitted to the Assembly at its Meeting on the 15th November next. In the meantime, I beg to enclose herewith a letter addressed to the President of the Council of Ministers of ~~Albania~~, asking to be supplied with certain documents which it is desirable should be laid before the Assembly of the League when the question of ~~Albania~~'s admission to the League is considered.

I beg also to enclose a further letter and telegram, asking for certain information on behalf of the permanent Advisory Commission of the League on Military, Naval and Air Questions.

I should be much obliged if you would communicate the substance of these enclosures by telegram to your Government, and would impress upon your Government the importance of supplying as much as possible of the information asked for at the earliest possible date.
