



MINISTER XHAÇKA AT THE "CRIMEA PLATFORM" SUMMIT: WE SUPPORT UKRAINE SO THAT SUCH ILLEGAL AGGRESSIONS DO NOT REPEAT THEMSELVES.

Albanian Minister of Foreign Affairs, Olta Xhaçka, participated in the virtual summit "Platform of Crimea" chaired by the President of Ukraine, Volodymyr Zelenskyy. In her speech, Minister Xhaçka mentioned that Albania supported Ukraine in its resistance, being one of the first countries to send ammunition, contributing to the Donors' Conference, approving the framework law that protects Ukrainians from the war, by aligning fully with all EU sanctions against Russia and by doing our utmost at the Security Council, as co-penholders with USA.

CONSULAR SERVICES FOR THE MONTH OF AUGUST 2022

During the month of August 2022, 12104 consular services were provided through the SHKO platform. Of these, 7906 are services for Passports and ID Cards and 3569 for Passes. The legalization office in the Ministry for Europe and Foreign Affairs processed 79,061 legalizations during this month.
